We offer a range of loans to suit different needs, whether you're borrowing for the first time, consolidating debts, or need some cash.

First Loan: Perfect for members borrowing for the first time, this loan makes getting started simple and stress-free. Borrow between **£200 and £5,000** with repayments over **6-36 months**, and enjoy the reassurance of Credit Union support and free loan protection insurance.

Granite Loan: A solid choice for returning members, helping you bring all your debts together into one manageable monthly payment. Borrow up to **£7,500 plus your savings balance** over a period of up to **5 years**, making repayment easier and giving you a clear path to financial stability.

Guarantor Loan: If your credit history isn't perfect, this option could help, with the support of a guarantor, you can borrow between **£500 and £5,000**. It provides an affordable, structured way to access funds without hidden fees, and interest is calculated on a reducing balance.

Loyalty Loan: A simple and affordable way for members with smaller savings to borrow, while keeping your savings protected. Borrow up to **£1,000** with a low **6.5% APR**, and continue to save as you repay, with quick, easy arrangements and loan protection insurance included.

Loyalty+ Loan: Designed for members who prefer to borrow against their savings, this loan offers a low **3.9% APR** and immediate decision. Borrow from **£1,000 up to the value of your shares** while keeping your savings secure, making it a safe and flexible option for those with no other loans outstanding.

Low Income Loan: Created to support members who receive benefits, this loan offers a manageable way to borrow. First-time loans are up to **£250 over 6 months**, with subsequent loans up to **£750**, helping cover essential expenses while staying on track with repayments.

Member Loan: For returning members, this flexible loan offers larger amounts with manageable repayments. Borrow up to **£15,000 plus your savings balance** over a period of up to **5 years**, ideal for achieving personal goals while benefiting from Credit Union support.



Alongside over 50 organisations, mostly not for profit, and we shared information, met other partners, and explored new collaborations, all while proudly representing our members. With hundreds of residents attending, and coverage from local media, Empower Aberdeen provided a vital platform for communities to know and connect with the support available especially, third sector support.

Increased FSCS Protection



The FSCS is the Financial Services Compensation Scheme which covers you if anything happened to any financial institution

The Bank of England has announced an increase to the FSCS protection limit, rising from £85,000 to £120,000 per banking institution from 1st December.

This change strengthens the security of savings and highlights the ongoing commitment of the Regulators to safeguarding savers money across all financial organisations including your money with the Credit Union.

Cash Perks It's simple!




Grampian Credit Union is committed to finding the right partners to support our members

As mentioned in our previous newsletter, Grampian Credit Union has partnered with **CashPerks** to make accessing your money even easier. This secure service helps members who may face challenges with traditional banking by allowing eligible members to withdraw cash directly from their Credit Union account at an ATM without needing a debit card, just a mobile phone.

Through a secure online portal, payments of £10-£500 can be sent instantly via SMS, and recipients receive a text with details to collect their cash from over 17,000 ATMs across the UK.

CashPerks is a safe, quick, and cost-effective way to send and access cash when you need it.



Make Saving Simple with Payroll Deduction

Grampian Credit Union partners with employers to help staff save or repay loans easily through payroll deductions. Employees enjoy secure savings, and all other benefits. Profits are returned as dividends, promoting long-term financial wellbeing and community support.

access to credit to keep rural homes warm

Do you need help to afford home heating oil to keep your home warm?

Are you:

- Living in Aberdeenshire
- Using home heating oil
- A householder on a low income
- Willing to take part in a pilot project?

We all need a little help and being able to access credit is important to be able to afford larger purchases, like home heating oil. Poverty Alliance and Grampian Credit Union are working together to help people access no interest loans to be able to purchase enough home heating oil to keep their homes warm.

How will this work?

Your nearest participating organisation can take your details to connect you with the Credit Union. These include: Aberdeen Foyer, Gordon Rural Action, Money Advice and Welfare Rights team, Scarf, Inverurie Community Partnership, Ballater Community Trust, Community Kitchen Stonehaven and Marr Area Partnership.

Once you have agreed a loan amount, and a repayment plan that is affordable for you, the Credit Union will pay this direct to your home heating oil distributor.



This is a pilot project - we want to know if it worked for you. You will be invited to answer a short anonymous survey about your experiences at the end, to help us understand what went well and what didn't.
